Thank you again for registering through LinkB5 to participate in VQB5, the state's uniform measurement and quality improvement system, for the 2022-2023 program year in your local community. As a teacher employed at SITE NAME who works at least 30 hours per week directly with children birth-5 (prior to Kindergarten entry), you are eligible to participate in **RecognizeB5**.

RecognizeB5 is a central activity of the <u>VQB5 statewide effort</u> and provides eligible teachers with a financial incentive of up to \$2500. The goal of the program is to recognize the hard work of early educators like you, and to reduce turnover in early childhood sites. Teachers who receive the financial incentive can use the funds however they wish; <u>there is no requirement or expectation that teachers use this incentive for work related expenses</u>.

RecognizeB5 is administered by the Virginia Early Childhood Foundation (VECF).

To receive the incentive, teachers must:

- Meet & maintain ALL eligibility requirements throughout the program year
- Opt-in to RecognizeB5 program participation each program year
- Submit an IRS W9 form each program year

To maintain eligibility and receive all incentive payments, teachers must be continuously teaching in a 0-5 classroom setting (not yet Kindergarten) for at least 30 hours or more per week <u>AND</u> remain employed at the site where they initially registered for participation in VQB5 each year. VECF will contact your site's administrator in January 2023 and May 2023 to verify your continued employment and eligibility.

Teachers who DO NOT maintain eligibility at *each* contact will not receive the full \$2500 in incentive payments. For more details, please review **important program guidelines and frequently asked questions in the documents linked here**.

By opting to participate in RecognizeB5 teachers acknowledge that **employment verification information** (*used to determine continued eligibility*) will be shared with VQB5 partners at the University of Virginia who are evaluating key components of the overall VQB5 initiative. W9 Form information will not be shared and all personal information will be kept secure and confidential.

PLEASE NOTE: If you have previously opted to participate in RecognizeB5 AND indicated that you DO NOT wish to complete the W9 submission process electronically, you WILL continue to receive these automated request messages until your W9 Form is received BY MAIL at our program office.
